






One little green frog in a pond am I;

and looked around.




Another wee rabbit

to their holes in the ground.






Three little ghosties,

and then there were three.




Three little pussy cats

and then there were two.




Two little pussy cats

and then there was none.







Sing a song of **six**pence,

And pecked off her nose.






One potato, two potatoes,
