## happen


What will **happen** on Christmas Day?

## hard


A stone is **hard**. It is not soft.

She does not like to get wet.

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
## hay

**History** is the story of the past.


We learn history at school.

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# horse



A **horse** is an animal. A pony is a small **horse**.
